We are excited to share that Lenart has received funding from the OST after school program, which is sponsored through the Chicago Public Schools, to provide after school opportunities for our students! The following are descriptions of the after-school programs that will be offered at Lenart this school year.

Quick Notes:

- Classes will start 12/11/17
- Students will be provided a snack from 2:45 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Parents will need to arrange for transportation to pick up students from Lenart at the designated time.
- Our funding is based on after-school attendance. We ask that students who sign up for the programs are committed for the duration of the program.

Please note that more programs may be added throughout the school year. Changes will be communicated to all parents.

Sports Club, Monday, 3:00-4:00. 10 sessions (12/11-3/5). Open to students in Grades 3-5.

Teacher Sponsor: Mr. Lin. During open gym time students will be able to participate in various sports stations, while learning the basic fundamentals of each sport, including indoor soccer and floor hockey. Students will be able to describe the sport, its rules, routines, equipment used, and safety of the games while working with peers to participate in playing the sport.

Volleyball Bootcamp, Wednesday, 3:00-4:00. 10 sessions (1/31-4/11). Open to students in Grades 5-8. Teacher Sponsor: Mr. Lin

Students will have the opportunity to learn and practice the foundational basics of volleyball such as bumping, setting, and underhanding/overhand serving. Students will also learn proper form when passing the ball as well as how to rotate appropriately on court.

Art Club, Monday– 3:00-4:00 10 sessions. (12/11-3/5) . Open to students in Grades K-2.

Teacher Sponsor: Mr. O'Connor

Come join us as we explore different types of art mediums in creating visual art pieces. This is the perfect opportunity to express your creativity!

Book Club, Monday– 3:00-4:00. 16 sessions. (11/27-4/23). Open to students in Grades 4-8. Teacher Sponsor: Mrs. Smolen.

The perfect combination for those who love to read and demonstrate their book knowledge. Join the Book Club as we prepare for Battle of the Books. Battle of the Books encourages ongoing reading, teamwork, and partnership throughout the course of the school year. Join us as we read, discuss, and prepare to compete with other Chicago Public Schools in the Spring!

Math Enrichment, Wednesday – 3:00-4:00. 10 sessions. (12/13-2/28) Open to students in Grades 4-8. Teacher Sponsor: Mrs. Downes.

Love Math? Students will have the opportunity to work together as well as participate in friendly math competitions with other students as we work on our problem solving skills in solving challenging math problems. This would be great preparation for Chicago Junior Math League as well as other academic math competitions

Writing Club, Tuesday – 3:00-4:00. 15 sessions. (1/9-4/24) Open to students in Grade 3. Teacher Sponsor: Ms. Chin.

This is a great opportunity for students to develop effective writing skills. Join us as we learn to create personal narratives and creative writing pieces. In this workshop, students will learn the art of “stretching a moment” when writing and specific strategies about how to return to a piece to improve it.

Yearbook Club, Tuesday– 3:00-4:00. 20 sessions. (12/11-4/23) Open to students in Grades 5-8. Teacher Sponsor: Ms. Chin.

Help your fellow students remember their days at Lenart! Be part of this year’s yearbook staff. Yearbook staff will take on a variety of responsibilities including taking photos, uploading them to the yearbook website, designing layouts, and completing the pages of memories. You Be the Chemist, Tuesday and Thursday- 3:00-4:15. 22 sessions (11/30-3/15) Open to students in Grades 6-8. Teacher Sponsor: Mrs. Doyle.

Middle School STEM, Monday- 3:00-4:00. 10 sessions. (1/29-4/16) Open to students in Grades 6-8. Teacher Sponsor: Ms. Villwock

During Middle School STEM, students will create and construct using various coding programs, while working together to question and problem solve through different puzzles, systems, and designs.

Spanish Dance, Wednesday- 3:00-4:00. 10 sessions. (12/13-2/28) Open to students in Grades 2-5. Teacher Sponsor: Ms. Torres.
